# Mind your investment goals and time horizons, investors told at ST Invest Seminar

While the outlook for global markets remains relatively buoyant in the short term, investors should be mindful of their goals and time horizons before jumping in.

This was one of the takeaways from The Sunday Times Invest Seminar, held on Saturday at the Fairmont Singapore and attended by about 600 investors.

The event, now in its second year, gave investors a chance to hear from veteran financial journalists and experts from DBS Bank, who shared their views on the global economy and investment strategies.

Chief investment officer at DBS Group Wealth Management and Private Bank, Mr Lim Say Boon, started off the seminar with his outlook on long-term trends in Asian markets, such as China and Indonesia.
